Dear Guests,

In February 2018, the National Assembly of the Republic of Slovenia adopted a new Promotion of Tourism Development Act, thus enabling municipalities to immediately increase the tourist tax to up to €2.50 per night and use this amount to develop their activities and infrastructure. In addition to the tourist tax, the Assembly will also introduce a mandatory promotional tax of an additional 25 % for the needs of the Slovenian Tourist Board, starting January 1st, 2019.

The Municipal Council of the Bled municipality decided to increase the tourist tax from the current amount of € 1.27 to the amount of € 1.50 for the transitional period from July 1st to December 31st, 2018. Starting January 1st, 2019, the tourist tax for the municipality will amount to € 2.50, while the national promotional tax will amount to € 0.63.

We would like to assure you that the Bled municipality will use these funds in a rational way, and with a view to ensuring that both locals and guests are feeling as well as possible. The greatest challenges that lie ahead for us are building the new bypass road to Bohinj, creating parking lots and cycling routes, especially in the direction leading towards Bohinj, and arranging the shore of the lake and the parkland surrounding it.

I thank you for your understanding and wish you a pleasant stay in the Bled municipality!
